



PRESENT TO HEAL BIBLE LESSONS

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Lesson 1 — THE BIBLE: THE BOOK FOR THESE LAST DAYS

This lesson reveals why the Bible is God's final message of hope, healing, and preparation for the last days.

1. What did Jesus call the Scriptures in His day?

The Scriptures consisted of the Law of Moses, the Prophets, and the Psalms—the full Old Testament.

Scripture: Luke 24:44–45

2. How many books make up the Bible?

Sixty-six books—39 in the Old Testament and 27 in the New Testament.

Scripture: Luke 24:44; 2 Peter 3:15–16

3. Were the writings of the apostles considered Scripture?

Yes. Peter calls Paul's letters Scripture, confirming apostolic writings are inspired.

Scripture: 2 Peter 3:15–16

4. What does the word 'Bible' mean?

Bible means 'The Book,' and Scriptures means 'Sacred Writings.'

Scripture: John 5:39

5. Who inspired the Scriptures?

God Himself inspired all Scripture.

Scripture: 2 Timothy 3:16

6. How did God communicate His messages to the writers?

Holy men of God were moved by the Holy Spirit.

Scripture: 2 Peter 1:21

7. Why is the Bible so unique?

Many authors, different backgrounds, one unified message—because God guided it.

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 14:33

8. For what purpose were the Scriptures given?

To teach, reprove, correct, instruct, and make us wise unto salvation.

Scripture: 2 Timothy 3:15–17

9. Who is the central figure of the Bible?

Jesus Christ is the center of all Scripture.

Scripture: John 5:39

10. How often should we study the Bible?

Daily, following the example of the noble Bereans.

Scripture: Acts 17:11

11. Who helps us understand the Scriptures?

The Holy Spirit reveals spiritual truth.

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 2:10–12

12. What standard protects us from false teaching?

The Word of God is the standard of truth.

Scripture: Isaiah 8:20

13. What must we do to receive the Spirit's guidance?

Be willing to obey God's will.

Scripture: John 7:17; Acts 5:32

14. How can we receive the Holy Spirit as our Teacher?

Ask the Father in prayer, and He will give the Spirit.

Scripture: Luke 11:13

15. What power does the Word of God bring into our lives?

The Word is living and powerful, transforming character and giving victory over sin.

Scripture: Hebrews 4:12; Psalm 119:11
