Lesson 2 — JESUS: THE WORD SENT FROM HEAVEN

This lesson reveals the identity, mission, and saving power of Jesus Christ—the eternal Word made flesh, sent to heal, restore, and redeem humanity.

1. Who did Jesus claim to be?

The Son of God.

Scripture: Matthew 16:13–17; John 3:16

2. What is Jesus' relationship to God?

He is one with the Father in character, purpose, and divinity.

Scripture: John 10:30; John 1:1,14

3. Did Jesus exist before His birth?

Yes—He existed from everlasting, before the world was created.

Scripture: Micah 5:2; John 17:5

4. What role did Jesus have in creation?

All things were made by Him.

Scripture: John 1:1–3; Hebrews 1:1–2

5. How was Jesus' birth supernatural?

He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of a virgin.

Scripture: Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:18–23

6. What example did Jesus set in overcoming temptation?

He lived a sinless life through dependence on the Father.

Scripture: Hebrews 4:15; 1 Peter 2:21–22

7. What did Jesus accomplish by His death?

He paid for our sins, revealed God's love, and opened the way of salvation.

Scripture: Romans 5:8; Matthew 26:28

8. Why is the resurrection essential?

It proves He conquered death and guarantees our future resurrection.

Scripture: Romans 5:10; Revelation 1:18

9. Where is Jesus now, and what is He doing?

He is in heaven serving as our High Priest and Mediator.

Scripture: 1 Timothy 2:5; Hebrews 4:15–16

10. Will Jesus return to earth again?

Yes—personally, visibly, and gloriously.

Scripture: John 14:1–3; Hebrews 9:28

11. Why did Jesus take on human nature?

To reveal God, defeat sin, and become our perfect example.

Scripture: Philippians 2:5–8

12. Can Jesus sympathize with our struggles?

Yes—He was tempted in all points like we are.

Scripture: Hebrews 2:17–18

13. What does Jesus offer to those who believe?

Forgiveness, new life, and victory over sin.

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:17; John 1:12

14. How do we receive the benefits of Christ's life and death?

By faith, surrender, obedience, and walking in the Spirit.

Scripture: Romans 8:3–4; Galatians 5:16

15. What decision does Christ call us to make today?

To accept Him as Lord, follow Him fully, and prepare for His return.

Scripture: Revelation 3:20; Joshua 24:15
