



MY BIBLE SCHOOL — Lesson 5 COMING AGAIN! The Blessed Hope

The Second Coming of Jesus is the blessed hope of the church. The Bible declares that Christ will return literally, visibly, and with great glory to gather His people and bring an end to sin forever. This lesson reveals what the Scriptures teach about His coming and how you can be ready.

1. Will Christ Come Again?

Yes. Jesus clearly promised, “I will come again.”

Scripture: John 14:2–3

2. How certain is His return?

As surely as He came the first time, He will return the second time.

Scripture: Acts 1:9–11

3. How will He come?

Openly, visibly, and gloriously.

Scripture: Revelation 1:7; Matthew 24:30

4. Will everyone see Him?

Yes — every eye shall see Him.

Scripture: Revelation 1:7

5. Will His coming be audible?

Yes — with a shout, the voice of the archangel, and trumpet of God.

Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 4:16

6. Will it be a secret coming?

No. Jesus warned against secret appearances.

Scripture: Matthew 24:26–27

7. Why is Jesus coming again?

To gather His faithful people home.

Scripture: John 14:1–3

8. What will happen to the righteous dead?

They will be resurrected at His coming.

Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 4:16

9. What will happen to the righteous living?

They will be caught up together with the resurrected saints.

Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 4:17

10. Will our bodies be changed?

Yes — we will receive glorified bodies like Christ's.

Scripture: Philippians 3:20–21

11. What happens to the wicked at His coming?

They are destroyed by the brightness of His glory.

Scripture: 2 Thessalonians 2:8

12. Does anyone know the day or hour?

No — only the Father knows.

Scripture: Matthew 24:36

13. What attitude must we have?

Be watching, ready, and living in obedience.

Scripture: Matthew 24:44

14. Who will be ready when He comes?

Those who love His appearing and live for Him daily.

Scripture: 2 Timothy 4:7–8

15. What must we do now to prepare?

Come to Christ, surrender fully, and walk with Him daily.

Scripture: John 6:37; 1 John 3:2–3
